Research shows that children learn by playing, so hands-on experiences are an important part of each day. We focus on large and small motor development, dramatic play, gym and outdoor play, and children benefit from daily art and monthly cooking class. Field trips and in-school programs enhance learning.

In addition to age appropriate reading/ literacy and math, we prepare children to be good students by working on self-confidence, following directions, self-control, social skills, independence, manners, and respect in all classes. Older children also study social studies, science, government and geography. Small class sizes allow teachers to individualize the learning experience, which is crucial in preschool and Kindergarten, when children are at many different levels academically and physically. Each lead teacher has a degree in early childhood education or a related field and Fairlawn Lutheran School meets or exceeds the State Early Childhood Education requirements.

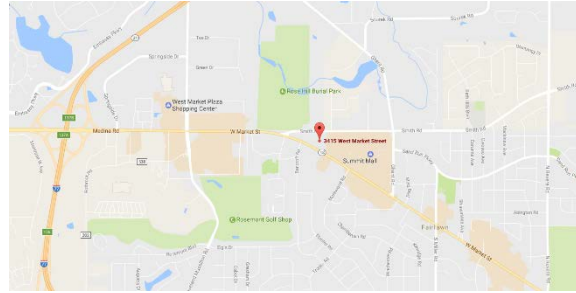
